Volunteer requirements

For the safety of riders and drivers alike, you must:

- Be at least 21 years old*
- Have a current New Jersey driver's license
- Have a clean driving record for at least three years and no criminal record
- Be reliable, punctual and have good interpersonal skills
- Agree to an interview and background check

Volunteer benefits

Our volunteers report a sense of reward that comes with helping others. In addition, they also receive:

- Volunteers can accumulate or "bank" a ride for every 4-hour shift they work. Rides can be saved or transferred to others but must be used within the calendar year they are awarded.
- Driver Safety Course.
